What We Will Be Learning

In Math, we will continue our <u>Addition and Subtraction</u> unit, in Science we will finish up our <u>Hearing and Sound unit</u>, and in Social we will start learning about <u>Ukraine</u> and how to be <u>Global</u> <u>Citizens</u>!


