
Suggested Activities

Sentence Parts

This activity allows students to go a step further in constructing super sentences. In this activity, they must pick sentence parts from the cans and place them in the correct order.

Teacher Preparation

Teacher Preparation


- 1. Reproduce the simple sentences on pages 53–55.
